

Missouri Association of School Psychologists Scholarship Information

MASP is sponsoring four \$500.00 scholarships for school psychology students in the State of Missouri. A total of three scholarships will be awarded at the fall conference (one for each of the approved Ed.S. training programs in Missouri and a third student scholarship for a doctoral level student at the University of Missouri – Columbia). At the spring conference, a fourth scholarship award will be presented to a student at the internship level. Applicants for this final award must be School Psychology Interns practicing in the public schools in Missouri, regardless of the location of previous training.

The purpose of these scholarships is to encourage students to complete school psychology programs and support employment of School Psychologists in Missouri public schools. Additionally, MASP hopes to increase student involvement and membership.

The award money may be used for living expenses, research, conference attendance costs, or any other needs related to academic preparation as a School Psychologist.

For School Psychology Student Scholarships (Deadline of September 30, 2011):

- Candidate must be a current member of MASP
- For the UM- Columbia and UM- St. Louis student scholarships, the student must be at least a 2nd year student and must not currently be completing an internship.
- Candidate must submit a completed application (see next page) by Friday, September 30, 2011 for School Psychology Interns to Michele Augustin at micheleaugustin@gmail.com
- Candidate must submit one letter of recommendation, including a statement verifying that the candidate is at least a 2nd year graduate student (or doctoral student if applying for the doctoral level award), from a faculty member in the school psychology program.

For School Psychology Intern Scholarship (Deadline of February 24, 2012):

- Candidate must currently be employed as an intern in a Missouri school district.
- Candidate must be current member of MASP.
- Candidate must submit:
 1. One letter of recommendation from a faculty member in the school psychology program currently attending
 2. One letter of recommendation from internship supervisor
 3. A completed application (see next page) by Friday, February 24, 2012 for School Psychology Interns to Michele Augustin at micheleaugustin@gmail.com
