Purpose:

To identify and recognize an outstanding school psychological examiner and to increase public awareness of the profession.

Who Can Nominate:

Any current MASP member can nominate a candidate. The nominator is responsible for submitting the completed nomination packet.

Who is Eligible:

Practicing school psychological examiners in the State of Missouri who spend the majority of their time providing direct services to students, teachers, and parents in school settings and who are current members of MASP. Trainers, researchers, or administrators are not eligible for this award.

Selection Criteria:

- Provides direct school psychological examiners services in line with current DESE certification competencies. (see DESE web site)
- Performs job in exemplary manner
- Earns respect of others
- Has current membership in the Missouri Association of School Psychologists
- Has current certification in Missouri as a psychological examiner.

Selection and Notification:

The MASP Public Relations committee members will review the nomination materials, validate entries, and select the award recipient based upon the nomination materials presented. The final selection will be voted on by the Executive Council. All candidates will be informed of the outcome.

Award Presentation:

An award ceremony will take place at the Spring MASP conference each year during the Membership Business meeting. The conference fee will be waived for the award recipient.

1. Nomination materials must be typed.
2. Nomination packets must contain:
  - Completed nomination form.
  - Nomination statement: In one page, describe why the candidate should be considered for this award. Give specific examples of skill based knowledge, exemplary job performance, and earns respect of others.
  - Candidate's resume
  - Letters of support: These should be one page letters written by individuals knowledgeable about the candidate's capabilities (e.g., teachers, parents, students, colleagues, administrators, etc.) At least one letter should be from and individual in the candidate's school system. No more than 3 letters of support should be included.
3. All nomination materials must be sent by September 30<sup>th</sup> in one envelope to Robin Martin, 5501 E. Teton Drive, Columbia, MO 65201.
